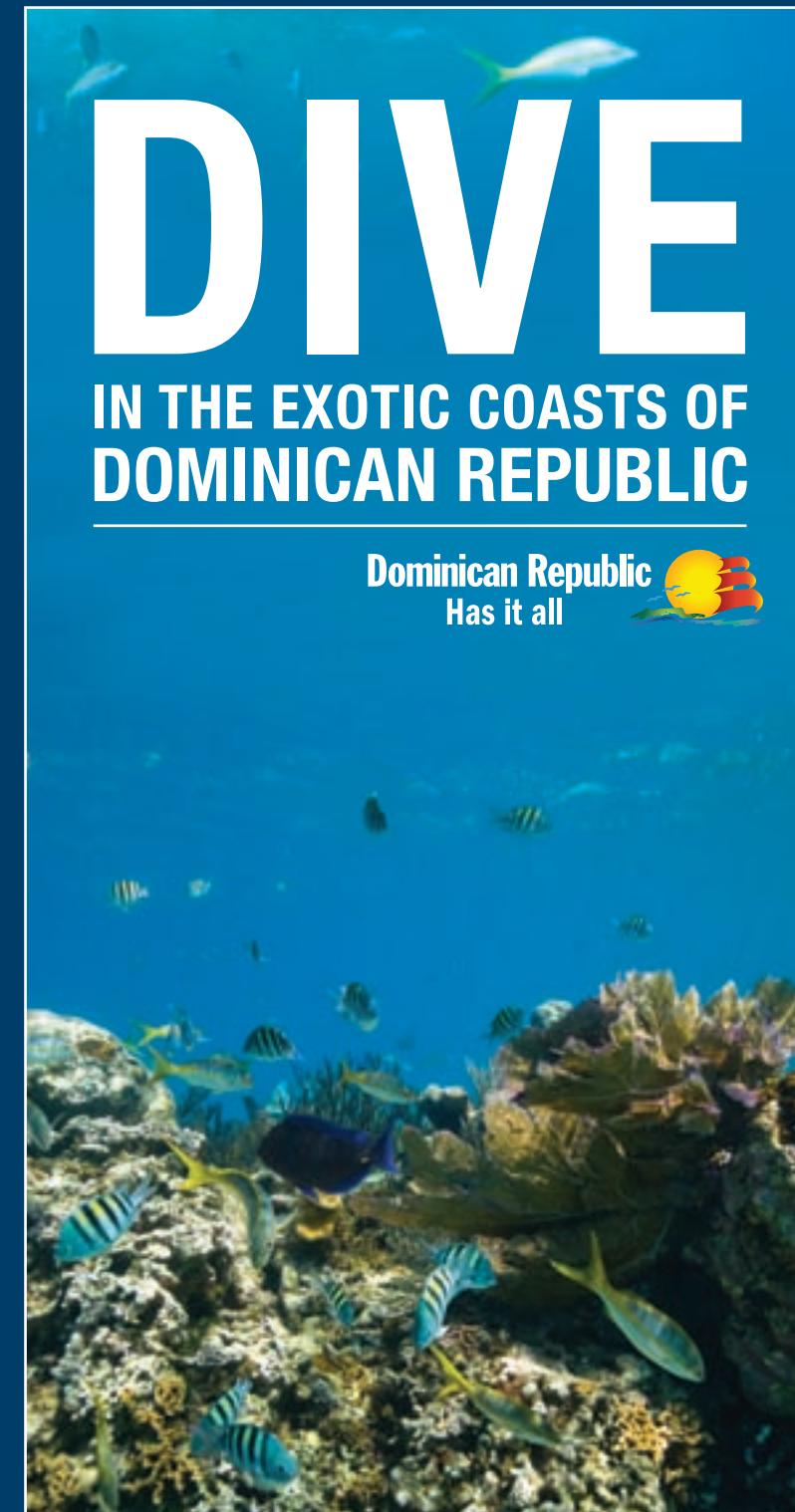

SHEER EXHILARATION – SANTO DOMINGO & BOCA CHICA

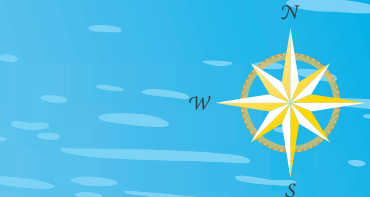
The area is home to illuminating coral, technicolored fish and an underwater national park, in addition to mysterious caverns. Well suited for both beginner and experienced divers.
